We are very thankful that after the past two years we are able to hold an in-person event of this size. I know all of you are excited to be together as well. **I just ask that we all remember to practice patience and kindness throughout the weekend.** Chris and I have been keeping track of attendee data since 2019; some people were refunded, then registered again, many new registrants are attending, and many things have changed. *If something comes up with your registration, know we will do our very best to fix it and make it right.*

We will be following CDC guidelines and with the [low COVID-19 Community Levels level in Barnstable County](#) at this time, we are not requiring masks during the event. Also, please be aware that the hotel is still under Covid protocols when it comes to the housekeeping staff:

- Hotel rooms will not stock paper items (including stationary, hotel pens, etc.) as these are considered high touch points.
- Housekeeping staff are not providing daily cleaning services and will not enter a guest's room once a guest has checked in. However, a daily "stay bag" is left outside the guest room which includes clean towels, coffee making supplies, shampoo, soaps, etc. To have your room serviced, just call the Front Desk by 1 pm and request a cleaning.
- To maintain social distancing, you will not be able to be in your room at the time of cleaning. The room attendant will be wearing a mask while cleaning your room.
- Hand Sanitizer Dispensers are placed throughout the public areas.
